



Direct Recurring Payment Authorization Form

We are pleased to offer you three ways to pay your annual assessment: (1) Direct Recurring Payment from a Bank Account, (2) Debit or Credit card, or (3) you can continue to pay by Check.

Direct Recurring Payment Plan/ACH Debit Authorization: This is the easiest and least expensive way to pay your bill, and your payment is always on time. If you want to sign up, complete and return the form below by December 15th, then every year thereafter, your annual assessment payment will be automatically withdrawn from your account 30 days after the invoice date. **You will receive your annual assessment invoice in late December as usual**, but if we receive this form by 12/15, it will now include a note saying that your payment will be automatically be withdrawn from your account; nothing to do!

Credit Card Payment: For the months of January-April, you can go to our website and click on "Pay by credit card" and then fill out the online form and use your debit or credit card to pay the current year's assessment. There will be a 3% convenience fee added by the site for using this option which will show on your credit card statement.

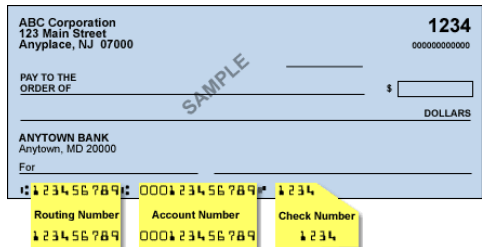
